CSAM

Child Sexual Abuse Material

CSAM (Child Sexual Abuse Material) is any visual depiction of sexually explicit conduct involving a minor. It is a form of child sexual exploitation and is often linked to grooming, coercion, and trafficking. Youth engaged in concerning or extreme CSAM behaviors, or exchanging CSAM for items of value, should be referred to a Regional Navigator for assessment and services.
