



Residential Substance Use Treatment Grant Program

DESCRIPTION:

The Residential Substance Use Treatment Grant Program assists state and local government agencies in the development and implementation of substance use disorder treatment programs for pre-trial defendants, individuals in correctional facilities, and citizens in need of post-incarceration treatment and community reintegration assistance.

Goal: To break the cycle of drugs and violence by reducing the demand for, use, and trafficking of illegal drugs.

ELIGIBLE TO APPLY:

- Maryland Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services (DPSCS)
- Maryland Department of Juvenile Services (DJS)
- Local Detention Centers

CATEGORIES FUNDED:

- Contractual Services
- Equipment
- Operating Expenses
- Personnel
- Travel
- Other

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

To qualify for funding under this grant, the applicant must propose to implement one or more of the following types of substance use disorder treatment programs:

- Residential treatment program
- Aftercare services for citizens in need of residential post-incarceration treatment
- Non-corrections-based residential treatment for pre-trial defendants
