

New: Organizational Capacity Questionnaire (OCQ)

What is the new OCQ?

The OCQ is a pre-award assessment tool from GOCPP used to determine risk and monitoring levels throughout the life cycle of a grant. It reviews an applicant's organizational stability, financial management practices, internal controls, and program operations. This replaces the Sub-recipient Organizational Capacity Questionnaire used previously.

How is it completed?

- The OCQ is completed in Qualtrics using the link: [Organizational Capacity Questionnaire](#)
- The OCQ must be completed by the entity's Chief Executive or Financial Officer.
- Every question is a required field in the form
- Best practice is to completed the OCQ in one sitting to avoid technical issues or data loss.

What information is needed?

Tip: Try having the preview of the questionnaire open in a separate tab while providing the information in Qualtrics. It is helpful as a guide.

Are there required attachments?

No. Documents and attachments will be uploaded in the Grants Management System based on the specific funding opportunity.

When does this need to be completed?

A new OCQ will be required to be completed once at the organizational level annually. It is not required to be done for each individual application.
